FROM ROADWAY**

The Town Board of the Town of Watertown does resolve, effective as of the date of this resolution, that in order to protect the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public and the residents of the Town of Watertown, every property owner of real property within the Town of Watertown shall ensure that the sign designating the property address and/or fire number of the property is reasonably visible and legible from the Town roadway to which the property is connected and shall make reasonable efforts to remove any object obstructing the clear view of the sign from the Town roadway.

**RESOLUTION
REGARDING SNOW REMOVAL FROM DRIVEWAY OR
SIDEWALK**

The Town Board of the Town of Watertown does hereby resolve, effective as of the date of this resolution, that in order to ensure the health, safety, welfare and convenience of the public all residents of the Town of Watertown shall abide by the following rules and restrictions relating to the removal of snow from private driveways and sidewalks located within the Town.

(1) No person may shovel, snow-blow, plow, or in any way remove snow or other winter precipitation from a private driveway or sidewalk onto any Town road, alley, highway, sidewalk, crosswalk, public roadway, or public right-of-way as that term is used in the Town of Watertown Code of Ordinances (Rev. 2011).

This resolution is made in conjunction with, and in no way limits, any regulation or ordinance already enacted by the Town, including Chapter 36 of the Town of Watertown Code of Ordinances (Rev. 2011).
