

Dog Licenses

All dogs over the age of five (5) months must be licensed per Town Ordinance and State Statute. Dog license period is January 1 to December 31, 2021. If you no longer have a previously licensed dog, please notify the Treasurer to remove the dog from our records.

Dog license applications may be submitted beginning mid-December by mail.

Dog License Fees

Unaltered Male or Female	\$10.00
Spayed Female or Neutered Male	\$ 5.00
Kennel license	\$50.00
Late Fee – per animal (after 3/31/20)	\$ 5.00

Complete the license application form below (more forms are provided on the back if more than one dog) and attach a **current copy of the rabies certificate**. If a rabies certificate is not provided, you will NOT be issued a license. Please note, the rabies certificate MUST identify the dog vaccinated. Documentation should also confirm spay or neuter status.

For license requests by mail remember to enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope to return your license to you. Rabies certificates are returned along with the license. Applications will not be returned. Make checks payable to: Town of Watertown
